

What to expect after your initial selection meeting

We know that you receive a lot of information during your design selection meeting. So, we have created this form to help with frequently asked questions about what to expect after your design selection.

1. After your initial selection meeting, your Legacy Interior Designer will send the selections to be priced by the builder's project manager.
2. Depending on the current stage of your house it might take several weeks for the drywall to be installed and then the Legacy team will go to the job site and accurately measure the space.
3. Once the job site measure is complete, the project manager at Legacy will email an estimate for the project.
4. Contact your Legacy Interior Designer to schedule your next meeting after you receive pricing from your builder. At this meeting you will review all selections and make changes to the selections if needed.
5. If all selections on the selection sheets are correct, then you will sign off on each selection sheet page with your approval of the selections. After signing off on the selections you will receive a copy and your interior designer will email a copy over to your builder as well.

What to expect after your initial selection meeting:

Pricing overages: Depending on the current stage of the house, it may be several weeks to receive your overage pricing. Only when the house has the drywall installed will a Legacy project manager go to the jobsite and measure the house. Any additional cost above the allowance for the tile, wood, LVP, and carpet will be calculated and emailed to you by the Legacy project manager. Once you have received the overages, please email your designer to schedule a finalization meeting.

All other material overage pricing: (Ex painting, cabinets, countertops, and stone) will be sent by your builder.

Any changes to the selections must be made in writing only and emailed to your designer. This ensures the accuracy of your selections and reduces miscommunications. It is the client's responsibility to confirm that everything listed on your selection sheets is correct after pricing has been received. Legacy will not be held accountable for selection discrepancies after client signs off on the selection sheets.

Once selections sheets are signed, they are considered final and you cannot make any changes. You will receive a copy of the signed selections, and the designer will send a signer copy to your builder. There are no returns, credits, or refunds on materials that have been ordered or unused.
